## Student Responsibilities

The Learning Resource Center (LRC) provides students with several tutorial and support services. The Supplemental Instruction (SI) program offers students scheduled and walk-in tutorial sessions, E-Tutoring, Online Tutoring, study skills workshops and access to interactive computer software programs. To make the most of your tutoring experience, we suggest that you follow the guidelines:

- 1. If you plan on traveling to BMCC only to see an S.I. Leader, it is recommended that you first call (212)220-1383 to confirm that the S.I. Leader is not absent.
- 2. Arrive on time for scheduled appointments
- 3. Attempt homework assignments prior to meeting with a SI leader/tutor
- 4. Study the course material before each tutoring session
- 5. Bring textbooks, questions for tutors and any other necessary materials to appointments
- 6. Tutoring/SI Sessions are limited to five (5) students per hour for each tutor
- 7. Students are only allowed to receive tutoring in courses for which they are registered
- 8. Tutors will help you learn how to complete your assignments; they will not do it for you
- 9. Bear in mind that a tutoring session is not a substitute for your class
- 10. Notify the tutoring coordinator or any SI Supervisor on duty of any issues
- 11. Ensure that you swipe in every hour for which you receive tutoring
- 12. Students are not allowed to eat or engage in any other activity in the LRC
- 13. Ensure that you safeguard your belongings when you are in the LRC
